## CARING for your MIRROR

- ◆ Ensure that the correct fitment procedures have been followed.
- ◆ To clean the mirror, we recommend using a chamois leather dipped in warm water and methylated spirits.
- ◆ Do not use acidic or alkaline (ammonia based) cleaners.
- ◆ Do not use an abrasive cleaner such as steel wool on the face or back of the mirror, as it scratches the glass or the protective backing.
- ◆ Do not apply cleaning fluid directly onto the face of the mirror as it could spill over the edge and onto the back of the mirror.
- ◆ Apply cleaning solution to a cloth and then wipe the mirror.

**DO**

ventilate room sufficiently prior to and during installation



**DO**

fit mirror above the work surface around the baths or hand basins (not flush to these areas), to avoid immersion of the edge in water

**DO**

use an approved edge sealer on edges of mirror



**DO**

paint the area behind the mirror with a high gloss enamel

**DO**

use only approved silicones and mastics



**DO NOT**

secure the mirror to an unpainted wall. Paint the area behind the mirror with a high gloss enamel



**DO**

allow for air circulation behind the mirror (6mm gap)



**DO**

apply mastics (tape, glue) vertically, to ensure excess moisture can escape freely

**DO NOT**

seal in the mirror by tiling around it and preventing air circulation behind the mirror
